Not only have Upper Room Children's Home been able to extend their Ministry to include boys and the boys home, but God has laid it on the hearts of another couple in the US to come and work with Ajaan Toy to build and run a Leadership Training College for Thai Pastors, so Pastors Ed and Birdie have purchased a home just across the valley from Upper Room with eight Rai of land. Once their home is completed (was partially built when they purchased it), they plan to move to Chiang Rai and build the College—probably about April 2007. Max has been helping with plumbing and advising Birdie on the best way to finish her home off—there is still a lot of work to do!!
